According to the applicant he has approached this Tribunal praying for a direction for expeditious disposal of his disciplinary proceeding and this Tribunal after hearing both the parties had directed the Principal Secretary, Finance (Revenue) Deptt., Govt. Of West Bengal to dispose of the departmental proceeding within 30.11.2016 and communicate the decision to the applicant within two weeks thereafter. But till date no such communication has been received by the applicant. The counsel for the contemnor/respondent has again made the same submission that the Finance Department has referred the communication letter dated 20.08.17 by Additional Commissioner wherein it is mentioned that proposal for punishment has been sent to the W.B.P.S.C. and they are awaiting the outcome.</p>
